All HJ Lea Oakes feeds come with the assurance that they are made under the Universal Feed Assurance Scheme

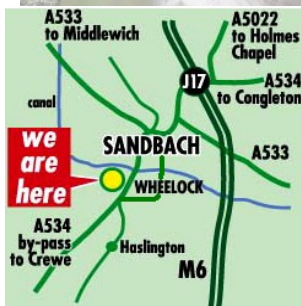

Ingredients

All the feed materials used in our Organic Compound feeds are of the highest standard and registered under with Organic Farmers & Growers.

Organic Maize, Wheat and Wheatfeed are the major raw materials used to provide a high energy source. All the compounds are formulated to contain the correct levels of calcium, salt and magnesium. Expeller proteins contain high levels of natural oils which contribute good levels of energy. Organic Soya expeller, Organic Sunflower Expeller and Organic Peas provide the major protein sources included.

Organic compounds are conditioned with steam before being extruded into 6mm diameter nuts, to minimize dust, to ease handling in bulk and bags and improve digestibility of the feeds particularly in younger animals.

Organic soya expeller and organic sunflower expeller are included in a flaked 'cake' form to minimize dust and give the blends an open texture.

Organic oatmeal and oat by product nuts are a by-product of the manufacture of organic breakfast cereals. They provide a unique balance of fibre ideal for balancing organic cereals.

The Blends are all formulated with Organic Molasses, improving palatability and reducing dust.
